Quick Statistics:

- The Kusaal language is from the Kusasi tribe and spoken by approximately 400,000 people.¹
- They are farmers, that live in villages, and their main crops are rice and yams.²
- The Kusasi people are 61% Christian with a growing Muslim population.²
- The Kusasi people of Ghana have a 22% literacy rate and strong oral traditions.³

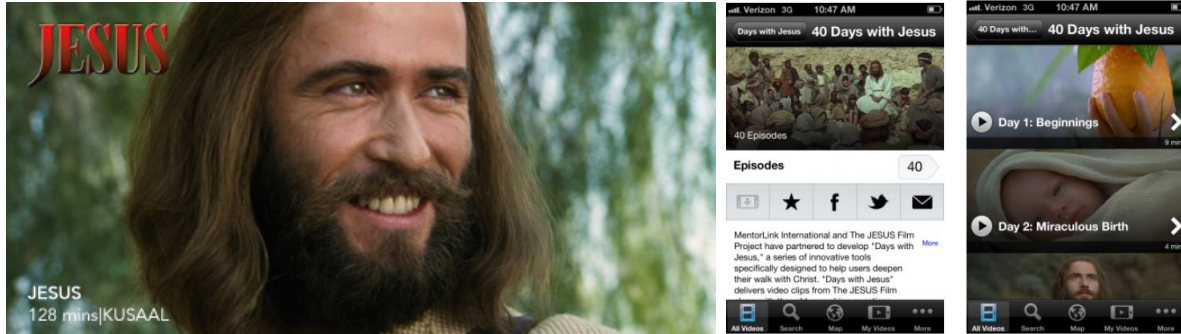

- The vision and model of training in orality of *VMTS* is to empower people across the globe in multiplying disciples of oral learners.



- **VMTS intends to incorporate DWJ Kusaal into their current vision to train church leaders across Africa with audio-visual technology, especially in hard to reach countries toward the achievement of the Great Commission.**
- VMTS also plans to distribute DWJ Kusaal with their current offerings of dramatized audio Bibles in over 50 languages, via 3GP files on feature phones, which are plentiful in Africa. These video files can be shared via MicroSD cards and also wirelessly via Bluetooth technology.



General DWJ Information:

- DWJ has become a powerful discipleship tool in many countries around the world
- It can be downloaded onto phones and does not require a person to be literate
- DWJ languages have reached over 163 countries
- DWJ is currently in twenty-nine (29) languages
- Five (5) different DWJ topics and two (2) animated instructional *How to Use Days with Jesus* videos are currently available
- 36.4 million discipling encounters using DWJ since 2011
