
MentorLink Pandemic Update

Shortly after the COVID-19 pandemic unfolded, Stacy Rinehart asked some of the MentorLink leaders to write a brief statement concerning the purposes of God for allowing these events to occur. My fundamental belief is that God is crushing many idols that I and others have embraced in our hearts: security, social status, significance, individualism. The list is endless. In the past twelve months, God has brought three highly experienced men to join the ML Canada team as part-time Associate Mentors/Trainers: Terry Dorey (Ontario), Gary Sharpe (New Brunswick), and Lorne Meisner (Manitoba). Each will serve about one day per week. I am also pleased to have Morgan Senior joining me in administrative leadership. We have begun to meet online to share our lives and ideas – a very exciting adventure for all of us. Several new possibilities for expanding ML Canada's ministry are:

2. Marketing online to engage with pastors willing to receive training in how to use our "Passing It On" tool to develop their leaders to become mentors who develop leaders.
3. Developing our new ML Canada website, which we hope will be ready by the end of August.

Recent Ministry Activities

In addition to mentoring younger leaders, I have really enjoyed two recent group activities:



1. Next Gen Leaders Conference (NGLC) – For three days in late April, I participated in my third NGLC, this time online. Approximately 100 young leaders from around the world participated. I shared one of the 13 mentoring groups with another mentor. The topic, “Prayer and the Word,” provided for rich discussions and life-changing takeaways. In June, we had one follow-up gathering with our group; another is planned for mid-July.

2. Hashtag Hope – In late June, I provided eight hours of online board development training for this newly incorporated charity whose ministry focus is the prevention of youth suicide. The two co-leaders and all but one of the board members are graduates of Heritage College from my time as president. They have asked me to continue mentoring them as they develop this important ministry.
